



FLUFFING, LIGHTING

Fluffing and Lighting



● Garland will arrive slightly flattened, packed into shipping boxes. Unpack your garland from the box, and fluff and reshape.



● Before beginning to light any type of foliage, always test the strand of lights.



● Start at one end and integrate your strand of lights into the foliage of the garland.

Ornamenting

- The design of your seasonal décor program may also call for the garland to be decorated with ornaments. First, set out your materials on a work surface in an organized, assembly line manner.
- Ready the ornaments by unwrapping them and attaching floral wire if needed. Then, fasten the ornaments thoughtfully throughout the garland.
- Be sure to secure the ornaments tightly into your garland. You want the ornaments to appear seated into the garland itself.



Storage



- Once you are ready to take down your décor, there are a few ways that you can pack your garland to keep it looking great year after year.
- The first way is to wrap it in plastic loosely, allowing it to breathe, then store all of the garland together.
- The second way is to carefully box up and seal your garland in cardboard boxes. The boxed garland can be stored on a shelf or stacked on a pallet in a temperature controlled storage area.
- Remember to label all décor program boxes as to their contents to keep things organized for installation the following year.
