



## Installing and Fluffing Large Bows

## **Bow Fluffing**

Remove your bow from its box. When opening the box, take care when cutting the tape, as the blade can go too deep and nick the bow.

On a flat surface, puff out the loops and the tails. Pull the two loops apart and push on the exterior edges. They ship flattened but contain a strong internal mesh to hold shape. This is a key part of having your bows look their best.









## **Bow Fluffing**

Locate the wire ties on the back of the bow and uncurl them. Note the locations of the grommets in each tail.



Center the bow where you would like to place it and extend the wires through the foliage and around the internal frame of the wreath. Pull as tight as you can and securely wrap the ties around the frame.



Locate the grommets on the back of the bow loops. Using zip ties or wire, secure the loops in an upright position. This prevents sagging and additionally secures the bow to the wreath.





You can use the same method to secure the tails to the side of wreath or in any position you prefer.



Double check that the bow is secure and even. As large bows are often attached in the air, it is often helpful to have someone on the ground act as a second set of eyes.
